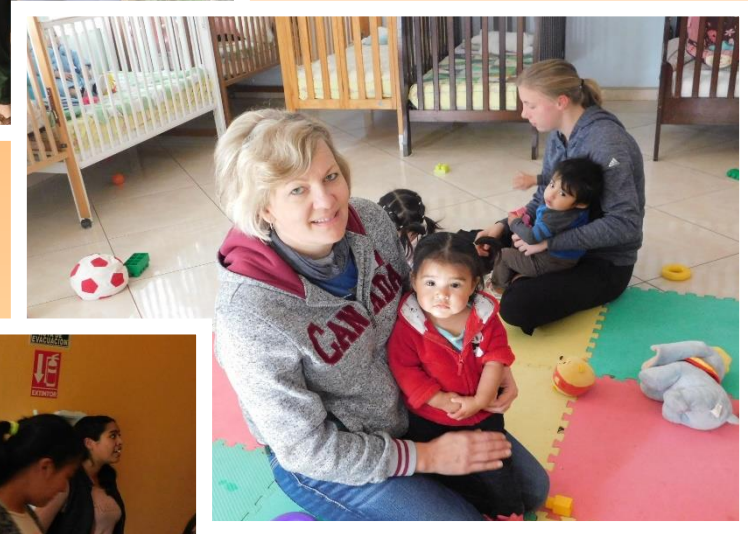

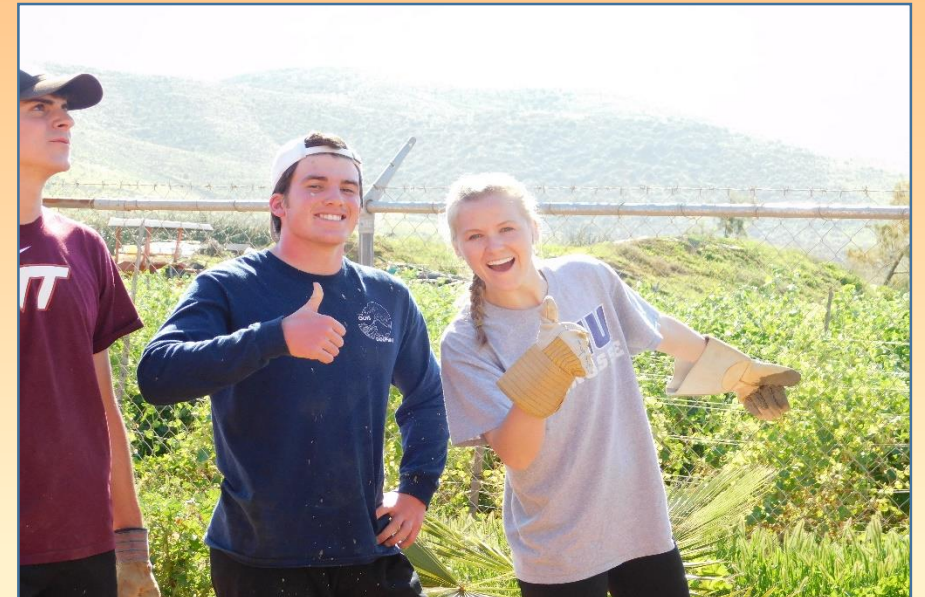

5- Please, request a copy of your Criminal Record Check at your nearest police station as it is necessary for all volunteers working with children to have one.

6- Suggested living budget is \$100-300 dollars per month, which covers personal purchases and extra expenses (restaurant, outing, small purchases)



CONSIDER BRINGING WITH YOU...

- Bible
- Cell Phone
- Passport
- Debit/Credit Card that is usable at MEX ATMS (talk to your financial institution)
- Driver's License (can obtain an international driver's license at your local licensing agency)
- Computer (optional but useful to have)
- Towels (we do supply but you may bring yours' if you wish to have your own or extra)
- Water Bottle
- Sunglasses
- Comfortable Shoes, Sandals, Boots, and Church Shoes
- Camera
- Coat (in case it gets cold, yes, it does get cold sometimes)
- Money for personal purchases.
- Sunscreen and Bug Spray
- Antihistamines (In case of initial reaction to dust or allergies)



- Any Necessary Drug or Supplement
- Bathing Suit
- Comfortable Clothing (See our dress code)
- Church Clothing
- Slippers
- Books or Hobby
- Pillow & Sleeping Bag (optional but can bring your own if you wish)



Our Dress Code
